The embroidery was designed to fit inside an adaptation of a beautifully constructed Nantucket shopping basket. Just the thing ladies carried when they visited their friends for tea! The sailing ships, mermaids and delightful colonial maids are all ready to grace your work as you create your own “needle story” on 36 count Edinburgh. The basket measures approximately 7” x 9” x 6” high. The assembly of the lining is actually quite easy and will be demonstrated in class.



Kit contains: linen for bands and accessories, silks, complete instructions, extra graph paper, photos, needles, cardboard for base, and Nantucket basket from Olde Colonial.

Students to bring: lining fabric of their choice (complete explanation will be in the student letter), the usual stitching accessories and lighting, if needed.
